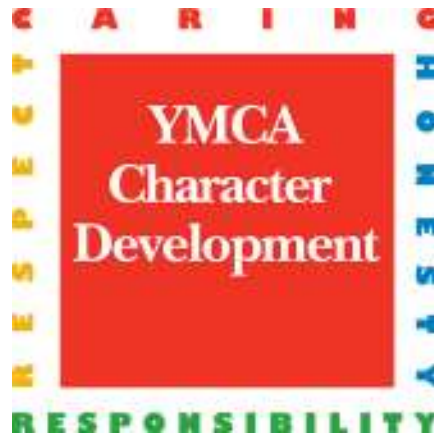

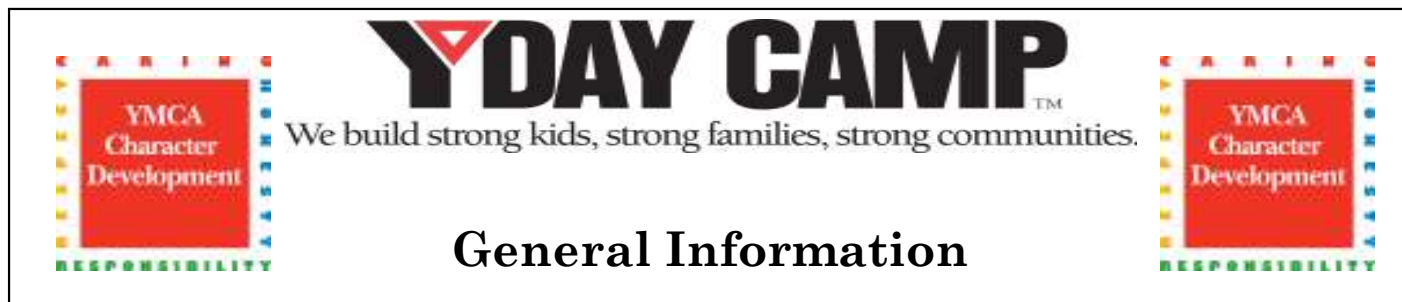

## General Information

### Registration Requirements

We must have a copy of your child's birth certificate and Health Records (physical and immunization records); along with the first week's payment and the \$35 non-fundable registration fee.

### Payment Policy

The first week's payment is due upon registration. Subsequent week's payment is due on the Friday before camp starts. You can pay via the YMCA drop box at the camp site. Make sure you have your child's name written on the check memo. If you would like a receipt sent, please provide a self-addressed envelope with your payment. No refunds are issued after **June 21<sup>st</sup>**. A two week written notice to the Piedmont Family YMCA office is required to cancel or change your registration. If you fail to provide the proper notification, you will be charged for the week.

### Reminders

Planned activities will take place between 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM, please have your child at camp no later than 8:45 AM. No child can be under the care of the YMCA for more than 10 hours a day. Supervised free play is permitted before and after camp for a limited time. Camp attire should consist of comfortable play clothes, socks, sneakers and sunscreen. NO open toed shoes or flip flops are permitted. Campers should bring a swimsuit, towel, and any other equipment they may need for swim days. We encourage all parents to label any items their child may bring to camp, because the YMCA cannot accept liability for lost or stolen items. It would be beneficial not to bring any items of value to camp. Field trip locations and times are subject to change without prior notice. On field trip days, please have your child wear the YMCA issued camp T-shirt. Camp will be closed on Monday July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2010 in observance of 4<sup>th</sup> of July. Camp specific rules will be established.

### Lunches and Snacks

All campers are required to bring their own nutritious non-perishable lunches, morning snack and afternoon snack including a drink. Please do not pack lunches that need to be refrigerated or microwaved because the campers do not have access to these appliances. Campers who attend KinderCamp will have USDA approved snacks and lunches provided for them.

### Financial Assistance Information

It is the policy of the Piedmont Family YMCA to provide services for any person who desires to participate. This policy is designed to ensure that all YMCA programs are accessible to all members of the community regardless of ability to pay. While participants are expected to pay their fair share of operating cost, those not able to pay the full tuition may be awarded assistance based on their demonstrated need, the YMCA's ability to fund the subsidy, and space available. You must fill out an application which is available at the YMCA. You must have your 2009 1040 form for income verification.

### Refund Policy

*The Piedmont Family YMCA Refund Policy is as follows:*

If the YMCA cancels a program due to low participation a full refund will be issued. Refund requests received prior to the start of a program will be offered a full credit, valid for one year, to be used toward any other Piedmont Family YMCA Program, or a refund check can be issued minus an administrative charge. Refunds may not be extended after a program starts (June 21st).

### Parent Consent

I agree to provide the YMCA with my child's Birth Certificate and Health records (physical and immunization). I understand that my child is not registered and is unable to attend YMCA Day Camp until the above documents are on file with the YMCA office.
- \_\_\_\_\_ In the event that I cannot be reached in any emergency involving the above name participant, I hereby give permission to the appropriate medical personnel, selected by the YMCA staff, to provide medical treatment deemed necessary by such personnel. I agree to be responsible for al charges incurred in the treatment of the participant regardless of whether our insurance covers such charges. When I receive a call from the YMCA staff indicating my child is ill, I agree to have my child picked up from camp immediately.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I understand that I'm responsible for payment of camp tuition and that weekly tuition will be paid to the Piedmont Family YMCA on Friday before each week of registration. Camp tuition will be paid for the weeks registered regardless if the child attends. There will be no refunds if the child does not attend. There will be a \$15 late payment fee for all tuition not received in advance on Friday.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Parent will inform the Piedmont Family YMCA within 24 hours or next business day after their child or any member of the immediate household has developed a reportable communicable disease, as defined by the State Board of Health, except for life threatening disease which must be reported immediately.
